

Rules for VAA Artwork Exhibit at Sumter Co. Pinellas Library

- A. VAA Membership dues for the year must be paid to enable you to participate
- B. Each artist may exhibit one (1) piece of artwork—more if space allows. The size required is 18 x 22 or larger. Small paintings just do not show up on such a large wall.
- C. A \$1.00 fee is required –it goes into our scholarship fund—for each painting.
- D. Artwork must be an original or a Giclee print
Not acceptable are: copies of other artists' works, published photographs, copies of greeting cards, prints, and artwork with religious or political themes.
- E. Artwork must be properly framed:
 - 1. Watercolors ,colored pencil, pen & ink or pastels must be in a frame with glass and have proper hanging wire.
 - 2. Acrylics do not need backing , but must have gallery wrapped sides(no staples showing) and the ability to be hung(Saw-tooth hangers are acceptable)
- F. Artwork must have been completed within the last 5 years.
- G. Artwork is to remain on display for 2 months—the duration of the exhibit.
 - a. If artwork is sold, you (the artist) are to inform the Exhibit Chairperson of the sale and arrange to replace the painting for the duration of the exhibit.
 - b. The librarians have nothing to do with any sales or handling the artwork.
 - c. Under no circumstances is the artist to remove the painting—allow the chairman to remove it so she/he knows what happened to it. The artist is to receive 100% of the sale price for sold artwork.
