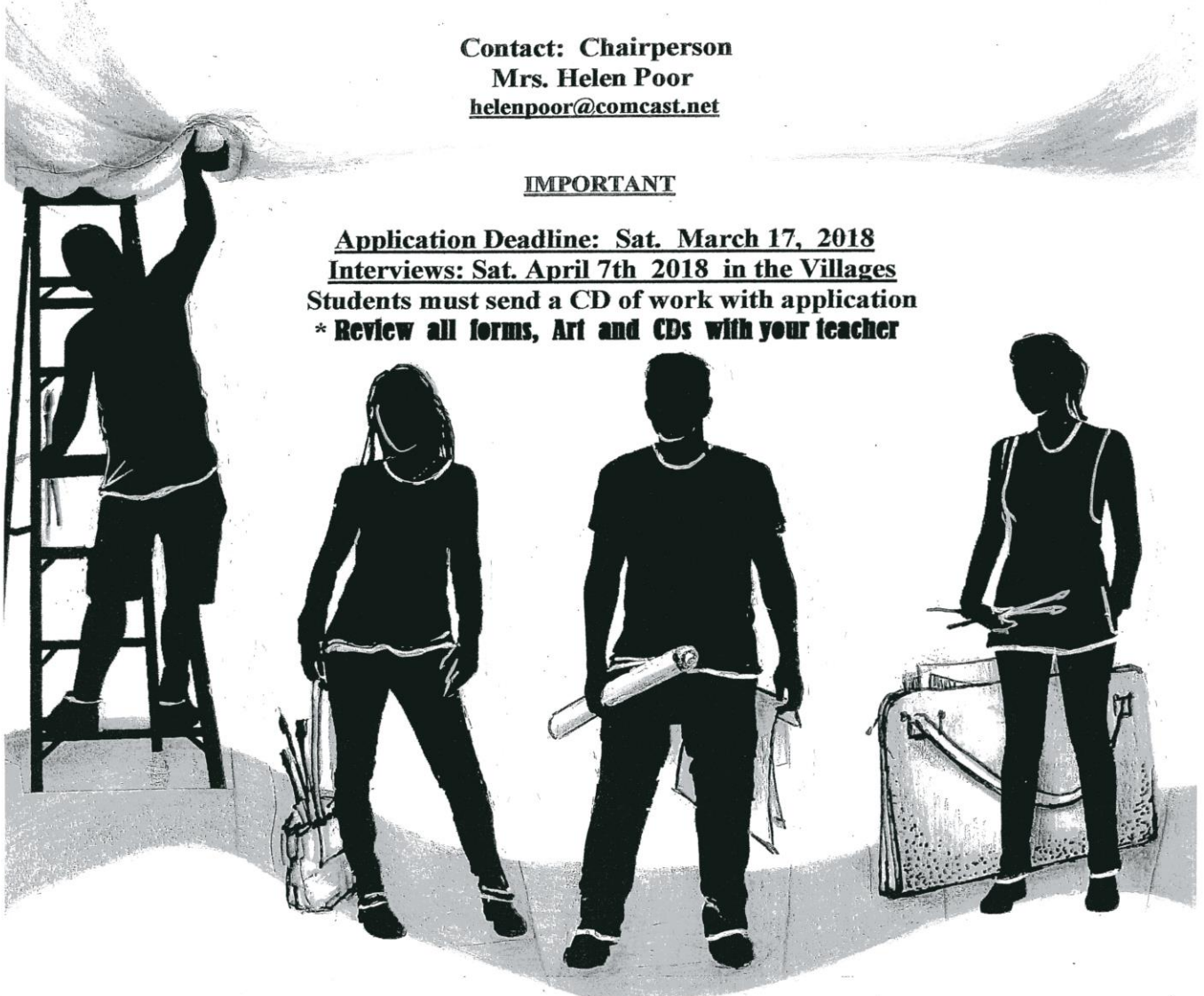

We welcome your interest in our Visual Art Scholarships being offered for graduating high school seniors. To date we have given over \$106,000 in aid to local winners. This year we will be awarding a minimum of \$1,000 and up to \$4,000 to graduating seniors who will be majoring in the visual arts. Examples of these majors being: Graphic Design, Architecture, Industrial Design, Photography, Fashion, Computer Animation, Painting & Illustration, Art History, Ceramics, and Art Education and others.

****Applicants must fulfill our criteria by submitting the following:**

- **A portfolio of examples (with various art accomplishments)** in a variety of media. **Good quality CDs of this art (in JPEG Format)** are to be sent with the application. Actual portfolios are shown at interviews.* Please see guideline sheets for submitting art and its presentation. No less than 12 and no more than 20 works on CDs.

- **A Statement of Intent as to the student's chosen field of interest or direction.**

- **Our Application** correctly filled out with biographical/ contact information: **Student must reside in Lake, Marion, or Sumter Co.**

- **Transcript of student's high school coursework**, including the most recent semester of study, also honors, and class standing.* **GPA must be a 3.0 or better.**

- **Two letters of recommendation** from individuals who have knowledge of such things as the student's talent, goals, character, employment and reliability.

(please no family references)

***Candidates will first be screened by the Scholarship Committee via the CDs and review of the student's application . Finalists will move forward for personal interviews.**

This group will be notified by E-mail or phone, of their appointment and given further instructions. ***Finalists will be interviewed, and show their actual art work in The Villages.** Winners will be contacted thereafter of awards toward college expenses. The committee will be looking for... and impressed with.... excellent art work, honors & accomplishments....also an informative and mature, personal presentation.

Students, we look forward to seeing your work, and speaking with you about your goals and future art education plans. *Check the above directions carefully before you submit your application packet.
