

VAA Online Art Challenge Rules

- Each artist may enter a jpeg picture of one piece of artwork per month (no matting or framing – send only a good resolution picture of your art up close).
- Art must be created during the previous month aligning with the theme. Eligible art can be either 2D or 3D.
- Work must be original. Reproductions of other artists' work, composition, published photos, or prints of any kind are not acceptable.
- No religious, political themes or nudes will be accepted.
- Art must not have won or have placed in any other contests
- Dues for the fiscal year (Sept 1 through Aug 31) must be paid in order to participate.

The purpose of the Online Art Challenge is to encourage creation of new art on a consistent basis and to showcase those creations.

Entry must be submitted to the Newsletter Editor (ptace002@umn.edu) by the 8th day of the month, along with title and medium used.

A document showing each entry without identification (other than being numbered) will be published to members for voting purposes by the 15th of each month.

All votes must be submitted by the 22nd of each month.

Votes will be tallied to determine first, second and third place winners, announced to members, and pictures of their art published in the next VAA Newsletter as Banner Art. Ribbons will be awarded to winners.

All entries with identification (name, title, medium) will then be posted on the VAA Website each month following announcement of winners.
