ELIGIBILITY AND SHOW GUIDELINES:

1. The artist must be current with club dues and must have attended at least 3 meetings in the current year to be eligible for the show. It is the artist's responsibility to confirm compliance.
2. All work must be the artist's own work. VAA members must abide by federal copyright laws.
3. The show prohibits art with political or religious themes or nudity.
4. 3D art objects may only be designed and made by the artist using raw materials. (Examples: clay made into art objects; Jewelry made from gems, stone, glass, wire that has been cut, polished and put into a setting made by the artist and not manufactured; Wood that has been sculpted/carved into sculpture etc.) NO plastic, wooden beads, trinkets, ribbons, fabric, no "improved" art store items. These are considered craft items. Show leaders will ask for the removal of non-qualified items from display and sale.
5. No "clearance" or "discount" signs allowed.
6. Artists may use VAA Art Display cards for pricing their art (provided below).
7. All artists understand that emergency aisles must remain open and clear of any obstruction.
8. The artist will be responsible for any damage done to the neighboring artist's table and/or items because of his/her unsecured or improper use of space.
9. Neither the VAA nor The Villages Recreation Department assumes any liability for damages.
10. The artist agrees that their displayed artwork must remain in place until the completion of the show at 3pm.
11. Tables must be covered to the floor on all sides. All packing must be secured out of view. Spaces without a table may have room for easels or display screens that fit safely within a 12'x6' space. Each space will accommodate two 6' tables or one 6' table plus browse boxes or display screen.

TABLE ASSIGNMENTS & PRIORITY REGISTRATION:

1. *Priority registration eligibility limited to Board members, Past Presidents, Committee Chairs, Exhibit Installation Committee. Those eligible for priority registration will receive an email informing them of this status.
2. Refer to page one of the application for registration dates and deadlines. Table assignments are based on date mail is received. Submissions received prior to the stated dates will go to the bottom of the table assignment list.
3. You will receive an email to inform you of your room and space assignment. If your space choices cannot be accommodated, you will be given additional options.
4. A wait list will be kept according to date the registration was received in the event of an artist cancellation.
